- Comfort with correlated sub-queries and sub-selects - when to use them and when not to and why.
- RBAR. If you had to Google this, you're likely not the right fit.
- Deep knowledge of why a query will scan a table vs seek.
- Monitor SQL Servers and proactively resolve issues.
- Be on-call for emergency coverage in rotation with several other DBAs.
- When on-call, Respond to text messages within 1 hour.
- This role is very unique and not for everyone. However, it is amazing for the right type of individual.

The following skills are a plus:

- Architect and Design new and existing databases and tables.
- Use SSIS to import data, write calculation Stored Procedures/Views, and export data back out.
- Develop HA/DR strategies and monitor and maintain them. (Cluster, Mirroring, AlwaysOn, Replication, Log Shipping).
- Securing data and access to SQL Server.
- Design, implement, and maintain data warehouses/ODS systems using SQL Server Replication, SSIS, SSAS, and T-SQL scripting.
- Work with business stakeholders to create and maintain reports in SSRS using relational & SSAS data sources.
